Examples of work eg. photos, tapes, videos or slides. Please ensure material is of a high quality eg. slides are focused and clear. Maximum of six (6) examples of work.

Applicants are NOT to send original documentation. All example material is to be labelled.

The successful candidates will be required to provide a report on completion of the scholarship on a proforma that will be provided.
